
for our Dolphins!



In Victoria's coastal waters or bays, you might see dolphins all year round, from the shore or when out in a boat. Of course it's harder to spot them, and much less fun, when the weather is bad and the sea is rough.

WHEN WATCHING, PLEASE RESPECT THE DOLPHINS

When you're in or on the water, if you spot a dolphin, remember not to get too excited. (we know it's hard not to!) It's against the law to deliberately approach closer than 100 metres, or to chase or harass dolphins, so always observe the laws about how close you can be to dolphins or whales. Remember, over summer, many of the dolphins you see will be young, some just new-born calves – so be extra careful. You might like to consider going out with licensed dolphin tour operators on Port Phillip.







COMMUNITY DOLPHIN WATCH

DRI's Community Dolphin Watch is fun for all of the family. It's a great way to show you care about the marine environment. Over the past 10 years, it has given us a significant database of sightings, which has helped our researchers influence the protection of Victoria's marine mammals. But our researchers can't watch all of Victoria's coastal waters full time. We need your help - you can be our extra eyes from the shore or out on the water. If you see dolphins, please report your sighting to us.

HOW TO REPORT DOLPHIN SIGHTINGS

If you see dolphins just note the time, location and if you can tell, the number. You can report sightings on our web site (www.dolphinresearch.org.au) or by calling DRI on 1300 130 949. We have sighting maps available for the Bays and Gippsland Lakes.
