
## Peninsula Wine Country

## WINTER WINE WEEKEND

Mornington Peninsula Cellar Doors make you especially welcome over the Queens Birthday Long Weekend. Christened Winter Wine Weekend, across the Peninsula cellar doors are abuzz with their freshly bottled 2006 vintage Pinots and Chardonnays alongside other very individual varieties, blends & styles.

The opening event is the Winter Wine Fest (Saturday 9 June, 11am - 4pm, Red Hill Recreation Reserve, Arthur's Seat Road, Red Hill) an exhibition and tasting which traditionally marks the beginning of the annual extensive Winter Wine program. This site, which is familiar to many as home to Red Hill Market will be filled with Cellar Door wine tastings 50 wineries offering over 200 wines to taste. For food lovers there is delicious regional produce and meals to taste, while enjoying the sounds of local musicians. The popular wine seminars are free to attendees and are booked out very quickly on the day. They are a unique opportunity to taste wines, listen and learn, with a selection of the region's key winemakers.

Entry to this year's Winter Wine Fest is \$35 (inc GST) at the door (\$30 pre-booked with the MPVA) and includes a complimentary Luigi Bormioli wine tasting glass with a comprehensive tasting booklet. Wine can also be purchased & taken or freighted on the day.

And that's just the beginning...throughout winter wine weekend you can enjoy a gourmet frankfurt or Emu snag in a crusty bread roll with a glass of a recent trophy winning Elan wine, or keep the young amigos entertained at Five Sons while you warm up your body and satisfy your soul - learn how to dance and enjoy steaming paella or meze - but not all together at the same time!. Or visit the Annual Sunday Open Day at Elgee Park or the oncea-year open day on Sunday at Frogspond overlooking beautiful Port Phillip Bay. French fare and award winning wines by the fire in the Marinda Park rustic restaurant invite you to visit and enjoy soup at cellar door with live jazz. Explore the beautiful tranquil walking track along East Creek from Merricks Estate and try European style smoked meat platters each day at Northway Downs. Taste romantic Riesling at Paradigm Hill or visit James Halliday's 2007 Winery of the Year - Paringa Estate. Vertical tastings will be held at various wineries; slow food, pies, pinot and puddings at Barmah Park; or explore tastes of food and wine matching at Ten Minutes by Tractor.


## Celebration at Stonier





Pouring the Vines with Emily Devenport

Autumn sees our local vignerons up 'til all hours. It's vintage time and teams of pickers work through the vineyards to bring ripe, sticky, sweet buckets of grapes to the wineries where they are destemmed, crushed and fermented in a myriad of ways. Heady smells engulf cellar doors, all hands are employed plunging crimson crusts on bubbling vats.

Cool nights give way to sunny days and our thoughts turn to the rich, earthy flavours of Autumn on the Peninsula - mushrooms, lamb, figs, quinces, olives, pears, berries, apples, avocadoes, mussels, pink

schnapper, soft cheeses - and the fabulous local Pinots Noir, Cabernet, Shiraz, Chardonnay, Pinot Gris, Riesling and sticky dessert styles to accompany them at the table.

The 2007 vintage will be finished for many wineries before the end of March, vintages in years past often haven't begun until April. While yields are lower after such a long dry spell, as well as frost and hail damage in some vineyards, early signs are that fruit quality is high with good intensity

# xploring Southern Peninsula - with Emily Davenport

In Browns Road Rye you'll find the Peninsula's southern most commercial vineyard THE CUPS. Autumn new releases include the much lauded 2004 "Raimondo Reserve" Pinot Noir, Merlot and Shiraz. These reserve wines along with the Sparkling Blanc de Noir, White Pinot, Chardonnay, Pinot Rosé, and Pinot Port are available to taste at cellar door.

Recent show success has included a Gold Medal at the 2006 Le Concours Des Vins for the 2006 Pinot Rosé and the trophy for "Best Sparkling" at the Red Hill Cool Climate Wine Show for the 2005 Sparkling Blanc De Noir.
